No need to stand in long lines on 'Packet Pick-Up Day' (**Tuesday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>.**) to pay school fees and dues! <u>Dues & Fees:</u> To participate in class activities such as proms, banquets, and graduation, students must have paid ALL dues and obligations. The Student Activities Program is planned to serve the personal, social, and educational needs and interest of all students. The DOE recognizes that even with the state resource support, some financial burden will be placed on students and parents for the Student Activities Program. Fees are established by the Board of Education.

Make checks payable to <u>Castle High School</u> for the exact amount. Please include your child's name on 'memo' section of your check. You can pay for class dues, student government dues, and purchase a Kaulana (yearbook) by the end of the 1<sup>st</sup>. week, and Athletic Pass Booklet with <u>ONE</u> check payable to CHS.

**<u>Kaulana:</u>** As the school year progresses the cost of the

yearbook goes up. Students MUST keep their receipt for verification of yearbook payment at May distribution.

**Athletic Passes:** For \$25.00, K-12<sup>th</sup>. grade students can purchase passes to attend Castle sports events (regular season football (at-the-door \$7.00), girls/boys basketball, girls/boys volleyball games; and season wrestling & judo matches (at-the-door \$6.00). You get a \$400.00+ value for \$25! When you purchase a CHS athletic pass, 100% of the \$25.00 purchase price supports Castle High's sports programs.

Starting July 15, 2019 online applications will be available at <a href="www.ezmealapp.com">www.ezmealapp.com</a>. Please do NOT submit a paper application if an online application is submitted.

FYI...50% of Castle High's population qualifies for free or reduced meals! If your family qualifies, (based on the number of students who qualify) Castle High School qualifies for Title I money from our Federal Government to be used for student needs such as support services from colleges / community and needed supplies -materials & text books for classes.

Students can benefit individually by receiving:

- Free or reduced lunch/breakfast (Food helps your student succeed in school);
- Advance Placement Exam reduction in cost;
- SAT: Two waivers (College Admissions Test) one each for your junior & senior year;
- ACT Plus Writing: Two waivers (College Admissions Test) one each for your junior and senior year;
- Some colleges/universities provide waivers for free application with proof student took SAT/ACT Test using a waiver (Potential estimated saving of \$50-\$80 per application)
- NCAA Clearinghouse: free cost of registration

Your child's free or reduced meal status remains confidential. All students scan their IDs to receive breakfast and lunch without revealing a student's meal status. Forms are distributed the first day of school and are also available at the front office during the school year if there is a change in your economic status. Be sure parents complete, sign the form, and return it to school ASAP to meet Castle High's deadline to qualify as a Title 1 school. Thank you for your support.

## **Registration / Class Schedule Pick-Up –** Tuesday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>, 8:30 am – 10:30 am

**NEW STUDENTS** – New Registrations will take place in Room 7 from 8:30 – 10:30am. After July 23<sup>rd</sup>. students will register in the Registrar's Office on / after Wednesday, August 7<sup>th</sup>.

### **REGISTERED STUDENTS -**

<u>Step 1 - Class Schedule Pick Up In Cafeteria:</u> If you've paid for your fees by mail, a receipt will be attached to your schedule.

<u>Step 2 – Fee Payment if you did NOT pay-by-mail:</u> Will also take place in the cafeteria. Checks must be written for the exact amount only. No change will be given to the student. Please write your child's name on the check. *Please keep your receipt for verification of yearbook payment in May 2020.* 

### <u>Step 3 – Meal Payment, Bus Transportation, Athletic Booklets:</u>

\*Meal Tracker Payment – Will take place in the cafeteria. Official deposit slips are available in the newsletter, at the cafeteria information booth, main office and can be downloaded from our school website <a href="http://castlehs.k12.hi.us/">http://castlehs.k12.hi.us/</a>. Deposit money into your child's lunch account using a personal check, money order or cash. Suggested minimum deposit amounts are: 1) \$20.00 for full paying students, and 2) \$5.00 for reduced meal students. Free meal students are encouraged to deposit money into their accounts if they plan on purchasing a second breakfast, lunch, or ala carte items such as milk, water or juice. You must have money in your child's account before school begins. If your child had a balance at the end of last school year, the balance will have been carried over.

- \*Bus Transportation In the Cafeteria. Purchase quarterly/annual bus pass One way or round trip.
- \*Athletic Booklet Purchase in Cafeteria for \$25. See info above.

Step 4 - Locker Sign- Up and Join our PTO - "Families & Friends of Castle" - In the Cafeteria Courtyard.

<u>Step 5 - Student ID & Spirit Item Sales</u> – Room 6. Every student is required to have a valid Castle ID card. They will need a student ID to: take books out of the library; utilize the library computers for class work / projects / research / typing; and utilize our MealTracker debit system to purchase breakfast and lunch. All incoming Freshmen and new students need to have their photo IDs taken, and all returning CHS students must pick up their ID cards from Rm. 6. August 8-23, IDs processed from 7:30-7:50a AND at recess; starting (8/26), processed TUESDAYS & FRIDAYS recess.


